JAN FRAN

Jan Fran is a journalist, TV presenter and Internet commentator best known for hosting The Feed on SBS VICELAND. She's the creator of opinion segment The Frant, guest-presenter of The Project and host of podcasts Sexism and the City and The Few Who Do.

Jan is a former TV journo-turned-VJ who has shot and produced documentaries from all over the world for SBS. She speaks three languages and has lived in Lebanon, France, Bangladesh and Uganda.

Jan appears regularly as a social commentator on Sky News and the ABC. She was a finalist for Best Television Personality in Cosmo's Woman of the Year Award and a finalist for the 2018 Walkley for Women's Leadership in Media. Jan is an ambassador for Plan International where she advocates for women and girls.

CRAIG FOSTER

Craig is Australia's most respected Football Analyst and lead sports presenter on SBS World News.

With 29 appearances for the Australian National Team (Socceroos) including as Captain, Craig spent a professional playing career in Australia, Asia and England followed by a multiple Logie winning broadcast career with the Special Broadcasting Service (SBS) alongside some of the great icons of football broadcasting including Johnny Warren and Les Murray.

Craig is perhaps equally as well known for his work beyond the field or screen, however, through the social programs he has developed and supports as well as his advocacy for sport and human rights. In 2018/19, Craig became a National hero in leading a global advocacy and lobbying campaign for an imprisoned refugee footballer in a Thai prison, Hakeem al-Arabi.

Craig is also a member of the Multicultural Council of Australia, tasked with ensuring the ongoing social harmony of Australia's diverse and changing population. He works with a vast range of social programs in indigenous football, homelessness, domestic violence, refugee advocacy as an Ambassador for Human Rights and Refugees with Amnesty Australia, developed a primary school initiative with the Australian Government for Harmony Day and is a former Chairman, Life Member and CEO of Professional Footballers Australia.

Craig has a Masters of International Sport Management, Postgraduate Degree in Football Management and is completing his law degree. Craig proudly attended Kadina High School, a public high school in Lismore.
