Our Impact...

Since 2009 the Public Education Foundation has given over one thousand scholarships to individuals in more than 300 schools across Australia, valued at more than \$3m.

The Public Education Foundation is committed to helping break the cycle of educational disadvantage and reducing inequality by supporting students and educators in Australia's public education system by providing life-changing scholarships.

In late 2018 the Public Education Foundation sourced Circa to undertake the *Monitoring and Evaluation Framework* for the Public Education Foundation Scholarship program.

An online survey was designed by CIRCA in collaboration with PEF. The survey was distributed and promoted via e-mail and SMS by PEF over a period of 6 weeks between 6 December 2018 and 14 January 2019.

The results, comments and percentages that follow in this report are based on the responses of 251 survey respondents.


- ✓ Inspired them to work harder and improve their academic results

Receiving a scholarship is empowering




- Assisted them to overcome disadvantage through the alleviation of financial stress
